

# ACEC Ohio Scholarship Program

The American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) of Ohio is the voice of Ohio's engineering industry. Council members - numbering 130+ firms representing more than 7,000 employees throughout Ohio - are engaged in a wide range of engineering works that propel the state's economy, and enhance and safeguard Ohio's quality of life. ACEC member firms employ engineers, architects, land surveyors, scientists, and other specialists, responsible for millions of dollars of private and public works annually. Member firms range in size from a single registered professional engineer to corporations employing thousands of professionals. The Council's mission is to contribute to America's prosperity and welfare by advancing the business interests of member firms.

To qualify for consideration for a scholarship, an applicant must be a full or part-time student (sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student status) pursuing an engineering or surveying degree and enrolled in an ABET accredited engineering or surveying program.

Amounts received as scholarships are excluded from taxable income if the funds are used for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses.

Criteria used in selecting grant recipients are:

- GPA
- School & work references
- Work experience
- Extra-curricular & community activities
- Quality of written essay

ACEC Ohio annually awards 4 scholarships totaling \$2,500 each.

# Applicant Eligibilty

Students must be entering their junior, senior, fifth, or master's degree year, in the fall of 2019 to qualify for the scholarships. In addition, a student must be a U.S. citizen pursuing a Bachelor's or Master's degree in engineering or in an accredited land-surveying program. ABET accreditation of engineering programs for scholarship applicants must conform to the following to the particular degree the student is pursuing:

#### Bachelor's Degree

Student must be in an ABET-accredited engineering program.

#### Master's Degree

Student must either be in an ABET-accredited Master of Science (MS) engineering program, or have a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree from an ABET-accredited engineering program.

## Scoring

#### I. Cumulative Grade Point Average: 20 points

#### II. Essay: 25 points

Essays must be typed or neatly printed. Points may be lost for poor grammar, incorrect spelling, illegibility, or lack of neatness. Proofread carefully.

#### II. Work Experience: 27 points

Work experience will be limited to the last three years prior to the date of the application. List your most recent work experience first and include any jobs held during high school if within the three year period. Indicate the year in school during which you held a particular position. Indicate if your work experience was in the form of work-study, co-op, or practicum. Clearly identify the nature of the business of the listed employers; in particular, note consulting engineering or land surveying firms. Be complete and accurate. List additional experience on a separate sheet and attach if necessary. The more experience you list, the higher your potential score.

#### IV. Recommendation: 15 points

A recommendation is needed from a consulting engineer, land surveyor or engineering professor. Use the attached form-a letter is not sufficient. Greater weight will be given for a recommendation from a consulting engineer or land surveyor. The evaluator must send the recommendation directly to ACEC Ohio.

V. Extracurricular College Activities: 13 points List all college activities including offices held and other leadership roles in any organizations. Be as complete as possible. If there are no activities, write "none". The more activities you list, the higher your potential score.
