MESSAGE FROM BETH

This past year at ACEC Ohio was one of trying to find the new normal, and we could not have done that without the support of our members, thank you! The key to this year was to be flexible and adapt our approach to serve our members at ACEC Ohio. At the board level key issues including wage pressures, finding talent, vaccine mandates and the implementation of the infrastructure bill were discussed.

Our strategic plan includes a goal of increasing the diversity of member companies by size, location, and discipline. To facilitate this, the State Public Works Committee was re-branded to the Vertical Development Committee with an updated mission to advocate for member firms in the vertical construction market. As part of our strategic plan, the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee presented a four-part training program to build personal and organizational inclusive intelligence attended by over 200-member firm employees.

An advocate on behalf of the industry, ACEC Ohio pushed legislation that will limit public authorities use of broad indemnification clauses and opposed a bill to reduce the gas tax. We worked to prevent bills that would change the qualifications-based selection process and dilute professional licensure.
