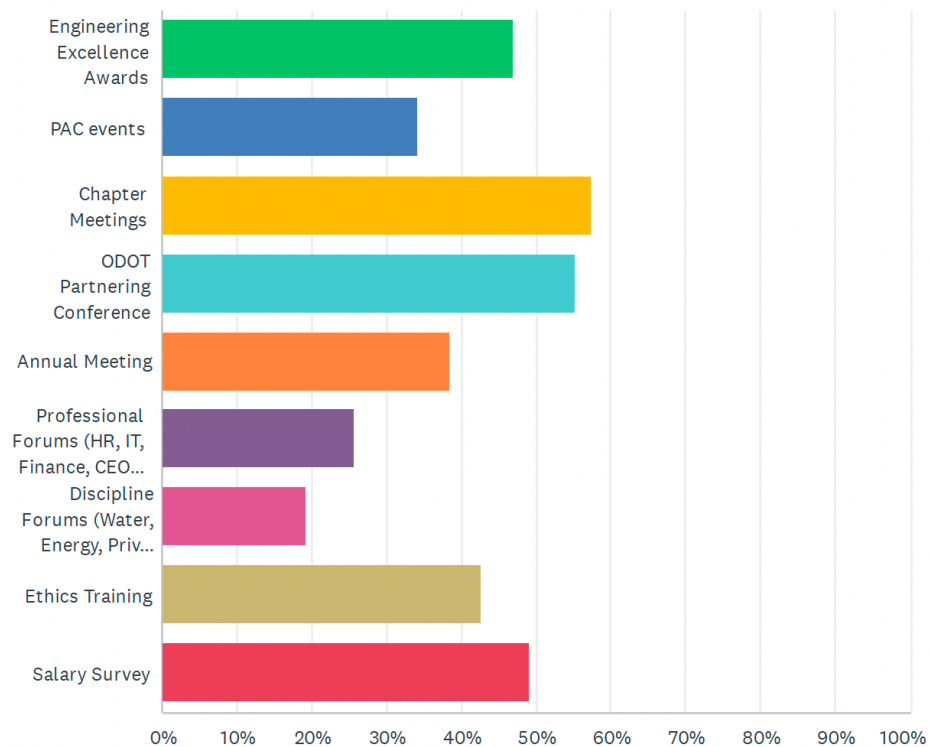
The survey also asked members to rank the benefits of being an ACEC Ohio member. The top three responses were:
